In its Order of June 7, 2016, In re the Rules for Admission to the State Bar of Montana (AF11-0244), the Montana Supreme Court adopted a recommendation to create a standing committee to periodically review issues related to legal education, testing, and bar eligibility and stated that the Court would entertain a petition from Dean Paul Kirgis of the Alexander Blewett III School of Law at the University of Montana regarding the structure and operation of that committee.

I. STRUCTURE

To effectively address the range of issues encompassed in legal education, testing, and bar eligibility, Dean Kirgis recommends the Standing Committee should include the following:

- Supreme Court Justice tasked with Bar oversight (Chair)
- President, State Bar of Montana
- Bar Admissions Administrator of the State Bar of Montana
- Chair, Board of Bar Examiners
- Chair, Commission on Character & Fitness
- Chair, CLE Commission
- Dean, Alexander Blewett III School of Law at the University of Montana

II. OPERATION

The Chair should organize annual meetings, giving preference to live meetings but with the option of telephonic or video-conferencing as participant's circumstances require. A summary of the Committee's review and recommendations, if any, should be submitted to the Court following each meeting. Committee members should be reimbursed by the Court for meals and mileage occasioned by their attendance.
