COMES NOW the Petitioner through her Counsel of record, Christopher W.

Froines and requests Leave of the Court to file a Brief in Reply to the Response

Briefs of HON. LESLIE HALLIGAN and ORION INTERNATIONAL, INC.

BRIEF

Based on the response briefs from Judge Halligan and ORION, it is clear that both are operating under the misapprehension that Petitioner's attempt to certify this case as a "class action" has been denied with finality.

In this Court's ORDER of May 15, 2018 affirming the District Courts denial of class certification, this Court upheld the District Court's denial of certification based on the grounds that Plaintiff failed to satisfy the superiority requirement.

While the original Motion to Certify the class was denied, there is nothing that prohibits Plaintiff from conducting additional Discovery to remedy the perceived deficiencies of class certification. Petitioner requests the opportunity to brief this issue to show that the District Court was operating under misapprehension of the law when it found the only issue remaining before the Court was whether the Defendant's actions were willful or negligent.

In the closing sentence of its opinion dated May 15, 2018, this Court stated, "based on the record <u>as it is currently developed</u>, we cannot conclude that the District Court errored by finding that Ascencio failed to meet the superiority requirement of M.R.Civ.P 26(b)(3)."

CONCLUSION

Based on the response of Hon. Judge Halligan and ORION, it is clear that the Court is operating under misapprehension of the law, or assuming that because the Motion to Certify Class was initially rejected, the Plaintiffs cannot file an additional second motion to certify after further developing the record through additional discovery. For this reason, Plaintiff requests leave to file a reply brief on the issue of recertifying the class by the making an additional motion to recertifying the class. The Courts discovery order has the effect of completely negating Plaintiffs ability to conduct additional discovery to remedy the District Court's perceived deficiencies in Plaintiffs Motion to Certify Class by refusing to order discovery and prohibiting Plaintiffs from contacting potential witnesses.
