

Mont. Rule of Appellate Procedure 12(10) expressly provides that "Motions to file over-length and supplemental briefs will not be routinely granted." The moving party must support the motion with an "affidavit demonstrating extraordinary justification." *Id*.

Plaintiffs/Appellees respectfully suggest that the issues identified in Appellants' supporting affidavit do not justify an order granting them leave to file an over-length brief. It is not uncommon for cases before this Court to include multiple issues involving statutory and constitutional interpretation. Based on its experience with such cases, this Court has established a reasonable limitation on

the length of briefs in Rule 11(4). Appellees believe the issues presented in this case can adequately be addressed within the limits established by that Rule.

For the foregoing reasons, Appellees oppose Appellants' Motion for Leave to File an Over-Length Brief.
