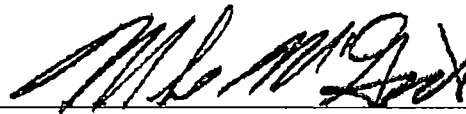

ORDER

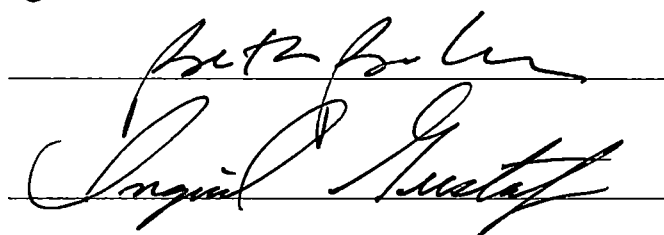
