
The Honorable C. B. McNeil, Judge of the District Court for the Twentieth Judicial District of the State of Montana, has requested the assistance of retired District Judge and Justice John Warner in Sanders County Cause No. DV 06-164, *Judith Newman, Personal Rep. of the Est. of Karlye Newman v. Worldwide Assn. of Specialty Programs and Schools, Inc., Robert Lichfield, and Peacox Enterprises, LLC*. The Honorable Judge Warner, having retired under the provisions of the Montana Judges' Retirement System, being subject to call for duty pursuant to § 19-5-103, MCA, and having advised that he is agreeable to assisting the District Court with the above matter,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED

1. The Honorable John Warner, retired District Judge and Justice, is hereby called to active service in the District Court of the Twentieth Judicial District of the State of Montana, to assume jurisdiction in that court's Cause No. DV 06-164.
2. The Honorable John Warner shall be paid the salary compensation to which he is entitled by § 19-5-103(2)(b), MCA.
