Carole M. Bosch (“Petitioner”) petitions this Honorable Court to waive the three-year Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (“MPRE”) test requirement for admission to the State Bar of Montana by Motion. In support, Petitioner states as follows:

Petitioner is seeking admission to the State Bar of Montana by motion. She has submitted the NCBE Character & Fitness Application and the Montana Application for the Montana Board of Bar Examiners & Commission on Character & Fitness. She has not taken the MPRE within the last 3 years.

Petitioner was required to take the MPRE in 2004, when originally seeking her license to practice law in California. The California Bar requires a passing MPRE score of 86. Per the attached MPRE Unofficial Score Transcript, Petitioner received a score of 122. She was admitted to the Bar of California in 2005.

Since being admitted to the California Bar in 2005, Petitioner:

- Is and has at all times been a member in good standing of the State Bar of California;
- Was admitted by motion to the State Bar of the District of Columbia in 2013 and has been a member in good standing since;
- Was admitted by motion to the State Bar of the Washington in 2018 and has been a member in good standing since;
- Was admitted by motion to the State Bar of the Oregon in 2019 and has been a member in good standing since;

- Has practiced law continuously as a civil litigation lawyer for law firms for 15 years without any ethical or disciplinary action in any jurisdiction where licensed or admitted to practice law;
- Is and has been an active member of local bar associations and state and national professional organizations; and
- Is has been a board member of a local bar association.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests that the Court enter an order waiving the three-year MPRE test requirement for admission to the Montana Bar, set a hearing in this matter, and for such other relief as this Honorable Court deems appropriate.
