Representing herself, Connie L. Judson (Connie) petitions this Court for an out-of-time appeal. As grounds, Connie states that she improperly filed via facsimile a Notice of Appeal with the Thirteenth Judicial District Court, Yellowstone County, and the Helena Office of Court Administration on June 1, 2020. Connie contends that the underlying proceedings were not fair. Connie presents a verified petition and includes a copy of the final judgment. We amend the caption to comport with the District Court's, pursuant to M. R. App. P. 2(4).

M. R. App. P. 4(6) allows this Court to grant an out-of-time appeal "[i]n the infrequent harsh case and under extraordinary circumstances amounting to a gross miscarriage of justice[.]"

On May 1, 2020, the Yellowstone County District Court issued a consolidated Order Affirming the Billings Municipal Court in two separate proceedings for a Temporary Order of Protection against the underlying Respondent Connie, the adult daughter of the underlying Petitioner, Jeanne. Jeanne and Lee each sought orders of protection from Connie in the Billings Municipal Court, which held a hearing. Connie then appealed both decisions to the District Court. Upon review, we conclude that Connie has demonstrated extraordinary circumstances to pursue this appeal. We further conclude that these cases and both District Court records will remain consolidated in one appeal. M. R. App. P. 4(3)(b). Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that Connie's Petition for an Out-of-Time Appeal is GRANTED and that Connie shall PREPARE, FILE, and SERVE a Notice of Appeal with this Court in accordance with the Montana Rules of Appellate Procedure and within thirty days, or on or before August 6, 2020. Failure to do so will result in dismissal of this appeal without further notice.

The Clerk of the Supreme Court is directed to provide a copy of this Order to all parties along with a copy of this Court's Civil Appellate Handbook.
