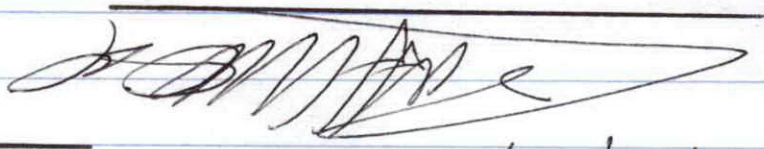
Comes now Terence R.
