The Honorable C. Bruce Loble, Chief Judge of the Water Court, having advised the Chief Justice that he will require the assistance of a retired district judge to assume jurisdiction in certain Water Court causes, and the Honorable Ted Mizner, retired District Court Judge of the Third Judicial District of the State of Montana, having retired under the provisions of the Montana Judges' Retirement System, having advised that he is agreeable in assisting the Water Court by assuming jurisdiction in various Water Court causes,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The Honorable Ted Mizner, retired District Judge, is hereby called to active service pursuant to §§ 3-7-201(2) and 3-7-223(4), MCA, to sit as a division water judge in any of the four water divisions, when needed and when requested by the water division judge or the Chief Water Judge.
2. The Honorable Ted Mizner shall be paid the salary compensation to which he is entitled by § 19-5-103(2)(b), MCA, and actual expenses, if any, shall be reimbursed.
3. A certified copy of this order shall be filed with the Water Court, and copies shall be furnished to the Honorable C. Bruce Loble, Becky Buska and Shelly Grandy in the Office of the Court Administrator.

This order is entered by the Chief Justice pursuant to Article VII, Section 6(3) of the 1972 Montana Constitution, and statutes enacted in conformity therewith and in implementation thereof.
