**PETITION TO WAIVE MPRE  
REQUIREMENT IN APPLICATION FOR  
ADMISSION BY MOTION TO  
MONTANA STATE BAR**

Christopher T. Wright petitions the Honorable Court to waive the three-year Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE) test requirement for admission to the State Bar of Montana by motion. In support, Petitioner states as follows:

Petitioner is a full time resident of Montana and is seeking admission to the State Bar by motion. Petitioner recently submitted his application for eligibility to the Montana State Bar and a Character and Fitness application to the National Council of Bar Examiners.

Petitioner has not taken the MPRE within the past 3 years.

Petitioner was admitted to the California State Bar in December 2003 and has practiced law continuously in California since that time. For admission in California, Petitioner was required to pass the California Bar Exam and also achieve an MPRE score of 86. Petitioner satisfied these requirements.

Petitioner has been a member in good standing of the California State Bar at all times since his admission in 2003.

Petitioner's practice has primarily focused on civil litigation, including business, employment and personal injury matters. Petitioner was an associate with several firms in Los Angeles and San Diego, and became a partner with the San Diego firm Kirby Noonan Lance &


1 Hoge in 2013. In July 2016, Petitioner formed the Law Office of Christopher T. Wright with an  
2 office location in downtown San Diego. Petitioner is a member of the San Diego County Bar  
3 Association.

4 Petitioner has never been disbarred or suspended, and has never had any ethical or  
5 disciplinary action taken against him by the State Bar of California. Petitioner has never been denied  
6 admission in any other jurisdiction.

7 WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests the Court to enter an order waiving the three  
8 year MPRE test requirement for admission to the Montana State Bar.


