P E T I T I O N

COMES NOW Jamie L. Young and respectfully petitions this Court for reinstatement to active status pursuant to Section 3 of the By-Laws of the State Bar of Montana.

Petitioner was admitted to the State Bar of Montana on April 16, 2009.

Petitioner was placed on inactive status by the State Bar of Montana pursuant to Rules 3B2, 5, and 12, of the Rules for Continuing Legal Education on July 12, 2021, as a result of noncompliance with CLE requirements.

Petitioner maintains that she complied with the Rules for Continuing Legal Education by timely submitting her CLE Reporting Form and supporting documents via U.S. Mail on May 8, 2021. However, the State Bar of Montana CLE has no record of Petitioner's submission.

Attached hereto at Exhibit A is email correspondence between MCLE Assistant and the undersigned, which confirms that Petitioner's CLE transcript has been updated to reflect that she has submitted the necessary credits for the 2020-2021 reporting year.

Attached hereto at Exhibit B is a receipt evidencing the Petitioner's payment of the \$50 Late Filing Fee and the \$200 Reinstatement Fee.

Petitioner is willing and able to pay active dues, fees, and the state license tax to the State Bar of Montana and comply with any continuing education requirements this Court may impose.

Petitioner is not currently suspended, disbarred, or otherwise ineligible to practice law in another jurisdiction.

Petitioner is not currently subject to disciplinary proceedings or pending disciplinary proceedings in another jurisdiction.

Petitioner has not been charged with a criminal offense while not on active status.

Petitioner has not accrued delinquent debt or filed for bankruptcy while not on active status.

Petitioner has not failed to fulfill the obligations of a public office or professional license (other than as an attorney) while not on active status.

Finally, Petitioner has not committed any acts or omissions while not on active status which would be sanctionable under the Montana Rules of Professional Conduct.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner requests reinstatement as an active member of the State Bar of Montana.

Pursuant to § 1-6-105, M.C.A., Petitioner declares under the penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Montana that the foregoing statements are true and correct to the best of Petitioner's knowledge and belief.

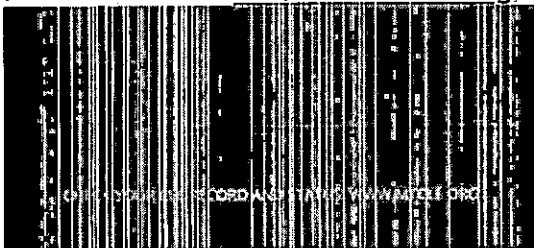

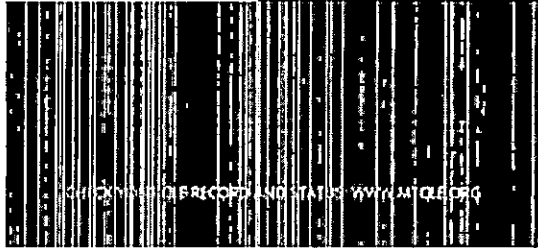
