ORDER

IN RE PETITION OF CHRISTOPHER G. MILLER
FOR REINSTATEMENT TO ACTIVE STATUS IN
THE BAR OF MONTANA

Christopher G. Miller has petitioned the Court for reinstatement to active status in the State Bar of Montana. Miller was placed on inactive status on July 12, 2021, for failing to comply with the Rules for Continuing Legal Education for the reporting year ending March 31, 2021.
