Dear Mr. Siegel:

We are in receipt of your letter to the Office of Disciplinary Counsel ("ODC") dated February 24, 2021, wherein you inform our office you would consent to reciprocal discipline in Montana. You briefly explain your position in the matter as well as some of the circumstances involving the representation of, and communications with, your former clients. ODC has treated and processed your letter as a self-report, pursuant to Rule 8.3 of the Montana Rules of Professional Conduct.

In addition to your letter, ODC has received and reviewed various documents from the Arizona disciplinary proceedings including the Final Judgment and Order, the initial grievance filed by your former clients, and your Agreement for Discipline by Consent.

ODC notes you were admitted to the Montana State Bar in 2017. Under information and belief, you have primarily maintained your law offices in Miami Beach, Florida. Since then, ODC has not received any informal grievances against you, nor has this office had to initiate any investigations your conduct, nor pursue any corrective or disciplinary action against you.

Having considered the totality of the information, ODC declines to pursue this matter for reciprocal discipline in Montana and thereby dismisses your self-report. Please be advised future violations may not be handled in the same fashion in Montana. While a self-report, you none-the-less, are entitled the right to request review of this dismissal by the Commission on Practice. If you wish to exercise this right, you should file a written request with ODC within 30 days from the date of this letter. We will in turn forward your request and any information provided to the Commission on Practice for its review.


