The Honorable Karen S. Townsend, Judge of the District Court of the Fourth Judicial District of the State of Montana, has advised this Court that she requires the assistance of a retired district judge to assume jurisdiction in the District Court of the Fourth Judicial District of the State of Montana.

Judge Townsend requires the assistance of a retired district judge to assume jurisdiction in Cause No. DV-10-1670, entitled *Cody William Marble v. State of Montana*.

The Honorable Douglas G. Harkin, retired District Court Judge having retired under the provisions of the Montana Judges' Retirement System, and having advised that he is agreeable in assisting the Fourth Judicial District by assuming jurisdiction in the above-entitled Missoula County case,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The Honorable Douglas G. Harkin, retired District Judge, is hereby called to active service in the District Court of the Fourth Judicial District of the State of Montana, to assume jurisdiction in the above-listed Missoula County case.
2. For all active service, the Honorable Douglas G. Harkin shall be paid the salary compensation to which he is entitled by § 19-5-103(2)(b), MCA, and actual expenses, if any, shall be reimbursed.
3. A certified copy of this order shall be filed with: the District Court Clerk of Missoula County with a request that the Missoula County Clerk of Court provide copies of

this order to counsel of record in Missoula County cause No. DV-10-1670. A copy of this order shall be furnished to the Honorable Karen Townsend, the Honorable Douglas G. Harkin and to Becky Buska and Shelly Grandy in the Office of the Court Administrator.

This order is entered by the Chief Justice pursuant to Art. VII, Section 6(3), 1972 Mont. Const., and statutes enacted in conformity therewith and in implementation thereof.
