Statement of Interest

ACLU is a nationwide, non-partisan organization with nearly two million members and supporters dedicated to preserving the principles of liberty and equality embodied in the Constitution and U.S. civil rights laws. ACLU-MT is the state affiliate of the ACLU whose mission is to support and protect civil liberties in the State of Montana. Amici have a long history of advocating in support of the rights of Indigenous peoples, those whose constitutional rights have been violated by law enforcement officers, and victims of gender based violence, particularly through the ACLU's Racial Justice Program and Women's Rights Project.
