## FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER REGARDING ATTORNEY'S FEES AND COSTS

The Court issued an Order Finding Respondent in Contempt and Awarding Attorney Fees in this matter on November 19, 2021, giving counsel for the Petitioner until November 29, 2021 to file an Affidavit of Attorney Fees. Petitioner's counsel filed an Affidavit for Attorney Fees on November 22, 2021. The Respondent then had until December 6, 2021, to file an objection. The Respondent filed an objection. The Court held a reasonableness hearing on January 25, 2021. The Petitioner appeared by Zoom and her counsel, Rebecca Swandal, appeared personally. The Respondent appeared by Zoom and his counsel, Jami Rebsom appeared personally. Petitioner's counsel testified and Petitioner called attorney Kevin Brown as an expert witness regarding the reasonableness issue. Counsel presented oral argument and the Court entered its decision on the record, which is now reduced to writing herein.

The Court finds and concludes that the attorneys' fees and costs claimed by the Petitioner are reasonable and should be awarded by the Court. Though the Respondent filed an objection to the fees and costs claimed by the Petitioner, the Respondent did not therein object to the reasonableness of the fees claimed, but rather objected to the contempt order itself and to fees being awarded at all. The Court nonetheless set the matter for a reasonableness hearing because

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	1 the Respondent had filed his Objection. At the hearing, the Respondent presented no testimony
	2 or evidence that would lead the Court to conclude that the fees and costs claimed by the
	3 Petitioner are not reasonable. The testimony of Kevin Brown was to the effect that the fees and
	costs claimed by Petitioner are reasonable, that Petitioner's counsel's hourly rate is at the low
	end of the range charged by counsel in this area, and that the time spent was reasonable for the
	services provided and appeared to omit charges for reviewing Respondent's Response and
	6 conducting research.
	7 The testimony of Mr. Brown is unrefuted. The attorneys' fees and costs claimed by the
1	Petitioner are reasonable and an Order should be entered for the sum claimed.
9	ACCORDINGLY, GOOD CAUSE EXISTS FOR ENTRY OF THE ORDER THAT
