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ORDER

Before the Court is Plaintiffs' Motion for Protective Order and Motion to Quash. Plaintiffs move the Court to enter a protective order, quashing the Deposition notice, and prohibiting Defendants from seeking the deposition of R.L.S. which they contend is unnecessary, harassing, and unrelated to any claim or cause of action against the Defendants seeking to depose R.L.S. The moving Defendants are Butte Central Catholic High School, Butte Central Schools, Roman Catholic Dioceses of Helena and Roman Catholic Bishop of Helena (Catholic School Defendants). The Motions are fully briefed, and a hearing is unnecessary. The Motion for Protective Order and Motion to Quash are DENIED.

Plaintiffs state R.L.S. is a juvenile victim suffering from emotional trauma and argue a deposition of R.L.S. puts his health and safety at risk based on the professional reports and

opinion of Roy Lubit, MD, Ph.D. Plaintiffs argue R.L.S. as a youth should be subject to increased protection in the discovery process and contend that all relevant information can be obtained from Amy Kadrmas' admissions of guilt, and prior interviews with R.L.S. and others. Plaintiffs also offer other methods of discovery, if necessary. Lastly, Plaintiffs assert the Defendants are using the discovery and deposition of R.L.S. to humiliate, harass, and cause more emotional harm to R.L.S..

Defendants contend they would be prejudiced by a protective order stating RLS's deposition is necessary because the lawsuit was initiated on his behalf and argue he is the sole source of evidence supporting the negligence claims against the Catholic School Defendants. Catholic School Defendants argue his testimony at trial is needed to establish any liability against the Defendants and as such it is necessary to depose R.L.S. prior to his trial testimony to gather all relevant facts. Defendants also contend there is no record of Amy Kadramas' admissions of guilt. Defendants assert Plaintiffs have failed to meet their burden to establish good cause, citing issues and inconsistencies in Dr. Lubit's conclusive statements and interpretive discrepancies with Plaintiffs case law.

A party may move for a protective order and the Court, for good cause, may limit discovery to protect a party or person from annoyance, embarrassment, oppression, or undue burden or expense. Mont.R.Civ.P. 26(c). The party moving for a protective order has the burden of showing good cause by demonstrating the harm or prejudice that will result from discovery. *Rivera v. NIBCO, Inc.*, 364 F.3d 1057, 1063 (9th Cir. 2004). Given due consideration of all the arguments, the Plaintiffs have not met their burden in showing good cause exists to prevent the harm or prejudice that will result from taking the deposition of R.L.S..

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The Motion for Protective Order and Motion to Quash are DENIED.
