The Honorable Kurt Krueger, Judge of the District Court of the Second Judicial District of the State of Montana has advised the Chief Justice that he will require the assistance of a retired district judge to assume jurisdiction of certain of his law and motion calendars. The Honorable Jack Whelan, retired District Court Judge of the Second Judicial District of the State of Montana, having retired under the provisions of the Montana Judges' Retirement System, and having advised that he is agreeable to assisting the Second Judicial District by assuming jurisdiction of the referenced calendars,

IT IS ORDERED:


1. The Honorable Jack Whelan, retired District Judge, is hereby called to active service in Department #1 of the District Court of the Second Judicial District, Silver Bow County, to assume jurisdiction in Silver Bow law and motion calendars beginning March 20 and through May 9, 2008.

2. The Honorable Jack Whelan shall be paid the salary compensation to which he is entitled by § 19-5-103(2)(b), MCA, for not to exceed sixteen (16) days' service, and actual expenses, if any, shall be reimbursed.

3. A certified copy of this order shall be filed with the District Court Clerk of Silver Bow County, and copies shall be furnished to the Honorable Kurt Krueger, the Honorable Jack Whelan, and Becky Buska, in the Office of the Court Administrator.

This order is entered by the Chief Justice pursuant to Article VII, Section 6(3) of the 1972 Montana Constitution, and statutes enacted in conformity therewith and in implementation thereof.
