MOTION FOR A STAY OF EXECUTION.

Due to an Appeal mailed on January 10, 2023 to the Montana Supreme Court, status uncertain at this time for Plaintiff, McGrea makes a Motion for a Stay of Execution.

Of course it would be ideal to postpone enforcement of Judgment until an appeal has been decided.

Due to the continued nature of McGrea's vehicle and home being accessed with other's breaking-and-entering, i.e. January 6, 2023 another pushed in the exterior driver's mirror as happened the week of Summary Judgment December 5, 2022 and Judgment, December 12, 2022, in Anaconda while consulting an attorney, upon return to my vehicle; upon making a thirty minute stop in Helena, and returning from Target January 6, 2023, another entered my vehicle and turned on the radio, which is not working, yet lights up and shows roosting station, which once engaged engine appeared when in fact radio was not utilized or turned on by McGrea, due to this continued and further illustrated activity on McGrea's privacy, I will continue to expose these details to the Court.

Additionally, a fifth phone McGrea acquired November 29, 2022, was commandeered with a sliding button for "cookielaw.com," where they took over my phone and locked me out of the use of the phone and access to my Supreme Court research.

Between Friday, January 6, 2023 after consulting with attorney, and Monday, a.m., January 10, 2023, another accessed McGrea's documents in her satchel, stealing a key document pertaining to her former employment, assuming at home, yet unknown when accessed, though McGrea carries her papers that are of utmost concern with her, when concerned regarding another breaking-and-entering, with eighth lock changed on front door.

The close of October, 2022, new University of Providence Librarian, Sue, brought approximately nine documents to McCrea while utilizing library, caustically assuming, though I pointed out only two were mine, these were my documents, then aggressively yelling at me, stating "GET OVER IT!!" McCrea is not certain what she is to get over, but the repeat of this yelling statement indicates this new librarian does not want anyone using the computers for document production, nor does she want someone using the books in the stacks. Sue did express plainly after my inquiring as to what she is concerned, that Team not to use the computers for document production.

The depths of Great Fall's encouragement of any continued education or working for one's legal defense or protection is bizarre and controlling. In this, the Court needs to know that when another's access to information or communications are controlled, like a Red Guard fiasco, things are going to miss, not falling on point.

This is what has happened constantly with McCrea's daily life and use of electronics, and in being people churned when sourcing legal materials. This is entirely outside of the pandemic restrictions and public denial to libraries and internet, with limited, very limited permissions once restrictions eased.

January 11, 2022, in stopping at the Eighth Judicial District Court, then later to the annex for mailings, McCrea returned home to a light she is certain she did not leave on. Shrugging it as my mistake, I went to use a halogen lamp this a.m. to find the entire top loose and unscrewed, with bulb not working. I need this lamp for document visual production. As a litigant and as a multi generational typical U.S. citizen, I have an absolute right to privacy and to litigate without bullying and astute, gestapo muscling to prevent my moving forward.

Whoever is bringing it to cripple my cause, I am going to keep exposing the details.

With this information, I respectfully request a Stay of Execution, even while my head is pounding insanely due to the previously illustrated reasons to the Court.

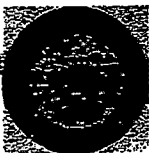

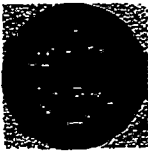

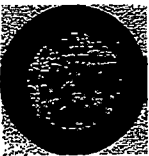

McCrea notifies (sp, not in my dictionary) the Court that McCrea received back an envelope addressed to Bill Levine, one ^{envelope} that I keep on my desk, stamped "no postage," where in an ordinary reflex, McCrea added postage and sent it through the mail handing it to the Postal Clerk.

Upon walking to my vehicle, I realized that the envelope was thin and flat as if holding only one sheet of paper, where my submissions to all parties have been requiring two ounces, and are multiple pages. The stamps used could be pulled off and look as if no postage was adhered.

As told to the Court in my Motion for Stay of Execution, another has been in my home the last week, if not once, several times, where McCrea's desk is in first room, after entry.

McCrea has worked as a Post Master for the Post Office, and does not recall missing adding postage this past week, or earlier, though could happen. Levine may be buying extra time or flat making it look as if I did not conduct my due diligence.

My envelopes if not taped, where one mailing recently was not taped, are pull open, where flap can be made to look not used. McCrea did not feel any tape on rear of envelope, but did not look. My type-writer is on desk in living room area described.

McCrea endured through early afternoon microwaving migraine, this day.
