In addition to exceptional circumstances in support for returning
 Emergency Suspension of Appellate Rules and Emergency Stay of
 Judgment and for Intermediate Release, Wenmer was not suppose to be
 placed in a DOC program.

On April 24th, 2023, Wenmer requested the authority allowing
 Wenmers incarceration and a copy of his MASC case file. The next
 day, April 25th, 2023, Wenmer was transported to the Montana
 State Prison, Montana Diagnostic and Treatment Unit (MDTU).

MASC staff would attend during Wenmer's incarceration at the
 segment only. The "PPD HOLD" portion was left blank. No PPD Application
 and Sentence (Dkt. 233), the warrant was filled out for arrest
 and Placement Warrant. In accordance with the District Courts' Study
 court of the DOC, by Rae Baker, submitted a PPD # 6.300(A) Notice of
 (MASC) on December 29th, 2023, after the Probation and Parole Divis.
 Wenmer was placed at Missoula Assessment and Transition Center
 2023 in this court.

transpired out of grievances Weimer submitted against MASC staff. Weimer had to personally relay the Complaints to the Human Resources Bureau because of MASC staff's refusal to do so.

Like unto Ingrid Gustafson, James Shea, Tim Rice, and Laurie McKinnon, Justices disqualitied pursuant to Montana Code of Judicial Conduct Rule 2.12 in Weimer's Notification of Disqualification of Justices and support for Stay of Judgment and Release filed in this Court on April 27, 2023, in this matter, So also the MASC staff devised my hurt, causing the following issues:

1. Unauthorized placement of my person in the Montana State Prison.
2. 22 hour lockdown every day for MDIU Classification, with an anticipated 120-140 day wait period according to staff.
3. I was denied a desk to draft work product in this matter; there are no tools except a law library on a tablet available for half a day once every four days, if the system is operational. This is a State Wide issue in all facilities as they change providers.
4. Weimer is currently in DOC "care and custody"; mail should be forwarded from MASC to him, but if not received would burden to remedy. The 7x8' cell is shared and is not designed for appellate briefing, let alone any practice at law.

Weimer has the entire record on his laptop work station, and the court reporter stated an electronic copy of the transcripts were also emailed to him. The Laptop work station has all the tools to effectively practice at law.

CONCLUSION

The remaining justices, Mike McGrath, Beth Baker, and Dirk Sandefur should consider these circumstances that have befallen upon Weimer when ruling on the Petition for Rehearing, on top of due process and delay violations.
