Attorneys for Amicus Curiae Treasure State Resources Association The Treasure State Resources Association (hereinafter "TSRA"), by and through their undersigned counsel of record, respectfully seeks leave pursuant to Rule 12(7) of the Montana Rules of Appellate Procedure to file an *amicus curiae* brief in support of Appellants in the above-captioned matter.

Counsel for TSRA has contacted counsel for all parties. Counsel for Appellants and Appellees have indicated they do not oppose TSRA's participation.

I. Statements of Interest of Treasure State Resources Association.

TSRA is a not-for-profit mutual benefit corporation organized according to the laws of the State of Montana and headquartered in Helena, Montana.

TSRA members are bound together by one commonality: economic activity through the responsible use of Montana's resources. TSRA members consist of other trade associations, individual companies, labor organizations, and companies providing professional services. Industries and associations in TSRA's membership include: agriculture; petroleum; hard rock, coal, and aggregate mining; timber and wood products; energy generation and transmission; transportation; contracting companies; and labor unions whose individual members work in the aforementioned industries.

These industries and their employees depend upon the responsible use and development of Montana's natural resources for their economic activity and livelihoods—and they rely on predictable state permitting, leasing, and licensing

processes and other state authorizations which to some level may involve the mission of greenhouse gasses, including carbon dioxide, into the atmosphere to produce, extract, and/or transport their products into the state and world economies.

If the Court were to adopt the District Court's ruling requiring substantive consideration of carbon emissions, TSRA's industries and workforce would be prejudiced by the implication of the decision and may be required to expend financial and personnel resources to implement a subjective consideration process, and potentially any resulting not yet established regulation, or altogether cease business activities that utilize Montana's natural resources. The outcome of this case raises significant issues that this group and its membership care about, and jeopardizes the economic viability of a large swath of Montana's most important economic sectors and large employers.

II. TSRA has a Distinct and Unique Interest in this Case.

TSRA and its members are uniquely positioned to assist the Court in understanding the broader implications and consequences the District Court's order may have upon Montana natural resource businesses. TSRA's members can provide the court with information regarding potential impacts to their business operations including issues of contradictory regulatory schemes, multi-state and

international commerce complications, and the impact to business and employment.

The concerns of TSRA are broad in scale. The implications, if the District Court's order were to be affirmed, could impact almost every facet of natural resources use in the state—from large commercial operations to a small scale farmer operating a combine harvester. A brief from TSRA is desirable for this Court as it is uniquely positioned to offer state-based and statewide insights and knowledge that would otherwise go unaddressed by other parties. No other party can offer the perspective of the collection of TSRA's membership operating in the State of Montana.

TSRA respectfully seeks this Court's leave to file an *amicus curiae* brief in support of Appellants. TSRA proposes to file its brief on or before February 16, 2024. This is three calendar days after the opening briefs of the Appellants are to be submitted.
