On June 27, 2001, the State Bar of Montana mailed written notices of noncompliance with the rules for Mandatory Continuing Legal Education (MCLE), via certified mail, to Gary L. Spaeth and to John Abbott Root Cooper. Those notices went unclaimed.

In separate orders issued July 25, 2001, this Court ordered Gary L. Spaeth and John Abbott Root Cooper to show good cause, in writing within sixty (60) days, why they should not be suspended from the practice of law for their failure to comply with the rules for MCLE. A copy of the pertinent order was mailed to Gary L. Spaeth and to John Abbott Root Cooper by certified mail, return receipt requested.

Two certified mailings of Gary L. Spaeth's order were attempted by the Clerk of this Court. The first, to a Helena, Montana, address resulted in its return, after three attempts by the U.S. Postal Service, as "unclaimed;" no address correction was noted and no forwarding address was provided.
