ORDER

Petitioner Eldena Bear Don't Walk has filed a petition requesting that she be allowed to carry over her July 2005 Montana Bar Essay Examination score to the July 2006 Montana Bar Examination. Petitioner states that she was granted permission by this Court to sit for the Montana Bar Examination for a fifth time in November 2005; however, due to several deaths in her family and health issues in the preceding months, she chose not to sit for the February 2006 Bar Examination. Petitioner further states that had she taken the February 2006 Examination, she would have been allowed to bring her July 2005 essay score forward for that examination and take only the Multistate Bar Examination, pursuant to Section III(D)(3) of the 2005 Rules for Admission to the Bar of Montana.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Petitioner Eldena Bear Don't Walk is granted a waiver of Section III(D)(3) of the 2005 Rules for Admission to the Bar of Montana. Petitioner shall be allowed to carry over her July 2005 essay score to the July 2006 Montana Bar Examination.

The Clerk is directed to mail a copy hereof to Petitioner personally and to the Bar Admissions Administrator of the State Bar of Montana.
