Comes now, Petitioner Benny Stewart and would move this Honorable Court for a Writ of Supervisory Control from the Second Judicial District Court for the County of Butte Silver-Bow in Cause Number DC 09-194, motion for Summary Judgment to vacate the judgment of the State of Montana for Lack of Subject Matter Jurisdiction.

Stewart's motion for Summary Judgment was filed on the 25th day of June, 2024 and the Butte Silver-Bow County Attorney was served on the 24th day of June, 2024, (see exhibit A); Stewart's reply to the State of Montana's non-response to Stewart's motion for Summary Judgment was filed on the 18th day of July, 2024, (see exhibit B); Stewart's motion for Summary Judgment Hearing was filed on the 29th day of July, 2024, (see exhibit C); Stewart's motion for a Resolution

and notice for filing Writ of Supervisory Control to the Montana Supreme Court was filed on the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ day of August, 2024 (see exhibit D) and was served on this Honorable Court.

Benny Stewart has complied with MONT.R.CIV.P. Rule 56.

The State of Montana concedes, there is no genuine dispute as to any material fact and Benny Stewart is entitled to judgment as a matter of law,  $(M.R.CIV.P.\ 56(E)(2)(see\ exhibit\ B)$ . Benny Stewart has shown by the court docket record, there is no genuine dispute as to any material fact and Benny Stewart is entitled to judgment as a matter of law, the record speaks for itself.

As of the **2**0th day of August, 2024 the Second Judicial District Court has not ruled in this case and has abused its discretion with this delay.

Barrus v. Mont. First Judicial Dist. Court, 2020 MT

HN4-Supervisory Control is an extraordinary remedy that may be invoked when the case involves purely legal questions and urgent or emergency factors make the normal appeal process inadequate. Mont.R.App.P. 14(3). The case must meet one or more of three additional criteria:

The case must meet one or more of three additional criteria (a) the other court is proceeding under a mistake of law

and is causing a gross injustice;

(b) constitutional issues of state wide importance are involved; or (c) the other court has granted or denied a motion for substitution of a judge in a criminal case, Mont.R.App.P. 14(3)(a)-(c).

Lack of Subject Matter Jurisdiction is an extraordinary circumstance that is a structural error that requires reversal.

The Second Judicial District Court proceeded under a mistake of law and caused a gross injustice to Stewart, violating Stewart's

Montana Constitutional laws and Statutes of Montana as well as the United States Constitutional Right to due process of the law and equal protection of the law.

Stewart's motion for Summary Judgment involves purely legal questions and urgent or emergency factors to protect the fairness, integrity and public reputation of the Second Judicial District Court and the judicial process of the State of Montana.

Summary Judgment Must Be Granted, M.R.CIV.P. 56, (see exhibit A-D).

Benny Stewart moves this Honorable Court for a Writ of Supervisory Control to rule in this case.
