MOTION TO VOLUNTARILY DISMISS APPEAL

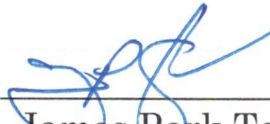
Appellant, Kaylene Jean Bowser, moves to voluntarily dismiss her appeal in this matter.
