JUDGMENT

Plaintiff Chad Stone filed a Complaint in the above-captioned civil action in which he alleged a state law claim for malicious prosecution and federal malicious prosecution claims under 42 U.S.C. § 1983; as well as claims for violation of the First, Second, Fourth, Fifth, and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution against Defendants City of Livingston and Courtney Lawellin. Defendants filed a Motion for Summary Judgment on December 12, 2024, moving for the dismissal of all of Plaintiff's claims against Defendants.

On January 8, 2025, the District Court issued its written Order Granting Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment on all claims asserted against them by Plaintiff.
