Counsel for the Appellant Steven Vandehey filed a motion and brief asking to be allowed to withdraw from this appeal on grounds that counsel has been unable to find any nonfrivolous issues to raise on appeal, pursuant to § 46-8-103(2), MCA, and *Anders* v. *California*, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S.
