On October 28, 2024, this Commission entered its *Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order* in this matter following a hearing on Respondent’s Rule 26 *Conditional Admission and Affidavit of Consent*. The *Order* required Ms. Gordon to appear before the Commission for a public admonition on a date and at a time to be set by subsequent notice.

By an Order entered December 20, 2024, the public admonition was set for January 10, 2025. However, on Respondent’s motion, the public admonition was continued to the Commission’s April 16, 2025 term. Respondent’s late-filed motion to again continue the public admonition was denied.

On April 16, 2025, at the scheduled time for the public admonition, Chief Disciplinary Counsel Pam Bucy advised the Commission she had spoken with the Respondent on April 15, 2025, to remind her of her required attendance. Ms. Bucy


reported Ms. Gordon was noncommittal. At the appointed time and place, Ms. Gordon did not appear. Her appearance was not excused and constitutes a contempt of the Commission. Accordingly, in accordance with Rule 9D, Montana Rules for Lawyer Disciplinary Enforcement,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Respondent is in contempt by her disobedience of a lawful order of the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT this Order of Contempt be submitted to the Montana Supreme Court for its consideration to issue an Order to Show Cause to Respondent to appear and show cause why her license to practice law should not be suspended or other discipline should not be imposed or, alternatively, determine the Order to Show Cause should be issued by the Commission in accordance with applicable procedures.




