IN RE PETITION OF JEAN YVES MEYER FOR REINSTATEMENT TO ACTIVE STATUS IN THE STATE BAR OF MONTANA

PETITION

COMES NOW, Jean Yves Meyer, respectfully petitions this Court for reinstatement to active status pursuant to Section 3 of the By-Laws of the State Bar of Montana.

Petitioner was admitted to the State Bar of Montana on: July 19, 2021.

Petitioner was placed on inactive status by the State Bar of Montana pursuant to Rule 3B2, 7 and 13, of the Rules of Continuing Legal Education on July 3, 2025, as a result of noncompliance with CLE requirements.

Petitioner is willing and able to pay active dues, fees, and the state license tax to the State Bar of Montana and comply with any continuing education requirements this Court may impose.

Petitioner is not actively practicing law in another jurisdiction.

Petitioner has not been employed as a law clerk while on inactive status.

Petitioner is an inactive attorney in the State of Colorado. Petitioner now resides in the State of Montana and does not practice law in the State of Colorado.

Petitioner is not currently subject to disciplinary proceedings or pending disciplinary proceedings in another jurisdiction.

Petitioner has not been charged with a criminal offense while not on active status.

Petitioner has not accrued delinquent debt or filed for bankruptcy while not on active status.

Petitioner has not failed to fulfill the obligations of a public office or professional license (other than as an attorney) while not on active status.

Finally, Petitioner has not committed any acts or omissions while not on active status which would be sanctionable under the Montana Rules of Professional Conduct. However, in the interest of full and candid disclosure, Petitioner reports that he was not aware of his CLE-related inactive status (effective July 3, 2025) until the afternoon of July 7, 2025. Prior to learning of the inactive status, on July 3, 2025, Petitioner filed a Note of Issue in a pending matter. Upon discovering his inactive status on July 7th, Petitioner immediately ceased all activities constituting the practice

of law and took immediate steps to seek reinstatement (filing the instant Petition one day after discovery of inactive status). During ordinary business, Petitioner likewise communicated with counsel regarding matters Petitioner was involved in between July 3rd, 2025 and July 7th, 2025. Petitioner respectfully submits that this inadvertent act was not willful and did not prejudice any party or proceeding. Petitioner has ceased and will continue to cease the practice of law unless and until such time this Court reinstates Petitioner.

Enclosed herewith is Petitioner's Compliance Confirmation from the Montana Commission of Continuing Legal Education.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner requests reinstatement as an active member of the State Bar of Montana.

The above statements are true based upon Petitioner's knowledge and belief.
