ORDER

MADISON WILLIAM MINER.

Defendant and Appellant.

Appellant Madison William Miner appeals his Ravalli County conviction for felony theft, to which he pleaded guilty after reserving the right to appeal the denial of his motion to dismiss for improper venue. Without conceding all of Miner's arguments, the State agrees that under the particular facts presented in this record and in the interests of justice, the Twenty-first Judicial District Court's denial of the motion to dismiss should be reversed and the matter should be remanded to vacate Miner's conviction and judgment.

Upon review of the parties' submissions, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the District Court's May 12, 2023 Order denying Miner's motion to dismiss for improper venue is REVERSED. The case is remanded to the District Court with instructions to vacate its October 25, 2023 Judgment.
