IN RE MOTION OF JORDAN D. KOSTELYK FOR ADMISSION UPON UNIFORM BAR EXAMINATION SCORE TRANSFER

ORDER

Jordan D. Kostelyk has filed a motion for admission to the State Bar of Montana pursuant to Rule IV of the Rules for Admission to the Bar of the State of Montana, governing admission upon Uniform Bar Examination score transfer. The Bar Admissions Administrator of the State Bar of Montana has informed the Court that the Commission on Character and Fitness has certified that Kostelyk has provided the necessary documentation and has satisfied the requirements prerequisite to admission under Rule IV of the Rules for Admission to the State Bar of Montana.

The petition also states that Kostelyk "filed a separate request that I be allowed to be sworn in offsite," but a copy of that document is not included with the petition and has not been located. Kostelyk may submit such a request for approval, including information regarding the judge and jurisdiction before whom she intends to be sworn. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that upon payment of any application fees and completion of any other processing requirements as set forth by the Bar Admissions Administrator, Jordan D. Kostelyk may be sworn in to the practice of law in the State of Montana.
