Statement of Issues Requiring Transcript Review

Appellant requests transcripts of all hearings identified in the minute entries because the following issues arise from **oral proceedings** and cannot be resolved without review of the recordings:


1. Whether statements and representations made by opposing counsel during hearings were treated as evidence or testimony despite not being sworn or subject to cross-examination.
2. Whether parenting time provisions included in written orders — including limitations on Christmas break parenting time — were imposed despite not being discussed, argued, or agreed to on the record during hearings.
3. Whether the District Court determined that a court order or issue was “resolved” when the matter was never addressed on the record and was not included in the final decree, including issues related to alleged back child support.
4. Whether subpoenas reflected in the Record on Appeal were issued but never served on subpoenaed professionals, resulting in the absence of testimony that was relied upon or referenced by the Court.
5. Whether the District Court made findings or comments regarding the parent-child relationship — including assertions that the relationship was fractured or unlikely to be repaired — while simultaneously concluding that parental alienation was not present.
6. Whether legal conclusions were stated on the record regarding the constitutionality or existence of alleged back child support obligations without proper briefing, evidence, or adjudication.
7. Whether oral rulings or statements made during hearings materially differ from the written orders entered thereafter.
