**PETITION TO PERMIT STUDENT PRACTICE
UNDER THE MONTANA STUDENT PRACTICE RULE**

Pursuant to the Montana Student Practice Rule (Rule), the State of Montana, by and through the undersigned counsel for the Montana Attorney General's Office, respectfully requests this Court allow Ms. Hannah Tokerud to practice before this Court in the above-entitled case, subject to the restrictions of the Rule. As grounds for this Petition, the undersigned submits supporting documents, attached herein, and states:

1. I am an attorney admitted to practice in this Court and am the attorney of record for the Appellee State of Montana in the above-entitled case.
2. I am requesting Ms. Hannah Tokerud, of Great Falls, Montana, be permitted to appear and practice in this case pursuant to the Rule. See Rule § II. B (student appearance in criminal matter on behalf of the state), § II. E. 2

(preparation of briefs to be filed in appellate courts), and § II. F (participation in oral argument in Supreme Court).

3. I certify that Ms. Tokerud:

a. is enrolled at the University of Montana School of Law, a law school approved by the American Bar Association;

b. has completed her second year of law school and thus has completed legal studies amounting to at least two-thirds (2/3) of the total credit hours required for graduation;

c. has been certified by the dean of the law school as being of good character and competent legal ability and as being adequately trained to perform as a legal intern (Dean's Certificate, attached); and

d. has certified in writing that she has read and is familiar with and will abide by the Montana Rules of Professional Conduct. (Student Certificate, attached).

6. I will ensure that at least one supervising attorney signs all written submissions in which the student participates.

8. I have explained to Yellowstone Deputy County Attorney Victoria Callender, who handled the State's case in the trial court, the terms under which Ms. Tokerud will participate in this case, and Ms. Callender has indicated her approval.
