OF MONTANA


Jason William Jording has moved for admission to the Bar of the State of Montana pursuant to Rule V of the Rules for Admission, Admission on Motion. The Bar Admissions Administrator of the State Bar of Montana has informed the Court that the Commission on Character and Fitness has certified that Jording has provided the necessary documentation and has satisfied the requirements prerequisite to admission on motion under Rule V. Jording also generally requests to be sworn in by a local Montana District Court Judge, but has not identified the judge who will do so. Therefore,


