PETITION TO PERMIT STUDENT PRACTICE UNDER THE MONTANA STUDENT PRACTICE RULE

Pursuant to the Montana Student Practice Rule (Rule), the State of Montana, by and through the undersigned counsel for the Montana Attorney General's Office, respectfully requests this Court allow Mr. Colin Phelps to practice before this Court in the above-entitled case, subject to the restrictions of the Rule. As grounds for this Petition, the undersigned submits supporting documents, attached herein, and states:

- 1. I am an attorney admitted to practice in this Court and am the attorney of record for the Appellee State of Montana in the above-entitled case.
- 2. I am requesting Mr. Colin Phelps, of Helena, Montana, be permitted to appear and practice in this case pursuant to the Rule. <u>See</u> Rule § II. B. (student appearance in criminal matter on behalf of the state), § II. E. 2. (preparation of briefs to be filed in appellate courts), and § II. F. (participation in oral argument in Supreme Court).

3. I certify that Mr. Phelps:

- a. is duly enrolled at the University of Montana School of Law, a law school approved by the American Bar Association;
- b. has completed his second year of law school and thus has completed legal studies amounting to at least two-thirds (2/3) of the total credit hours required for graduation;
- c. has been certified by the dean of the law school as being of good character and competent legal ability and as being adequately trained to perform as a legal intern (see Dean's Certificate, attached); and
- d. has certified in writing that he has read and is familiar with and will abide by the Montana Rules of Professional Conduct. (See Student Certificate, attached.)

- 4. I will assist and counsel Mr. Phelps in all work performed in this case.
- 5. I accept full personal and professional responsibility for my case and for all of the student's work.
- 6. I will ensure that at least one supervising attorney signs all written submissions in which the student participates.
- 7. I will ensure that at least one supervising attorney is present in person throughout the student's presentations in open court and will introduce Mr. Phelps in such appearances.
- 8. I have explained to Mr. Fred Van Valkenburg, Missoula County
 Attorney, whose office handled the State's case in the trial court, the terms under which Mr. Phelps will participate in this case, and Mr. Van Valkenburg has indicated his approval.
