David Garfield has petitioned the Court for permission to sit for the Montana Bar Examination for the fourth time. Rule III.L, Rules of Admission to the Bar of Montana, requires that an applicant who has been unsuccessful in three attempts to take the Bar Exam must obtain permission from the Court to retake the exam.

Garfield's petition explains the efforts he has undertaken to prepare for the examination and to place him in the most advantageous position possible to pass. The Court finds there is good cause to grant the petition.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition of David Garfield to sit for the Montana Bar Examination for the fourth time is GRANTED. Garfield must submit his application materials to the State Bar of Montana no later than October 21, 2014, if he wishes to sit for the February 2015 examination.

The Clerk is directed to mail a copy hereof to David Garfield and to the Bar Admissions Administrator of the State Bar of Montana.
